



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

For BC Series Utility Cart

- **1.** Unpack carton to confirm amount and identity of components.
- 2. Place caster in the bottom of post (FIRST GROOVE IS LOCATED AT 21/8" [5.4 cm] FROM END) (Fig. 1).



3. Place a wooden block on the floor. Lift both post and caster approximately 5" to 6" above block and tap assembly until caster stem seats. (Bottom of post contacts top of caster swivel) (Fig. 2).



4. Take four pair of split sleeves and place one pair on the first groove up from the bottom of each post (Fig. 3). Make certain that the bead of the split sleeves fits securely into the groove of the posts.



5. Take one of the flat shelves and standing it on its long side, insert a post from the underside of the shelf into each corner (Fig. 4). Carefully reverse the shelf and repeat this operation for the other two corners.



6. Stand the unit upright and apply pressure at **each** corner to seat the shelf securely and evenly on the posts (Fig. 5).

- 7. If a 2-shelf unit is being assembled proceed to step #16. If a 3-shelf unit (without end panels or enclosures) is being assembled proceed to step #10.
- **8.** For a 3-shelf unit with end panels, take a pair of single sided extrusions and slide over posts (Fig. 6 and Fig. 7). Position a short end panel over extrusion and slide down into the extrusions (Fig. 8). For BCE1627 see Fig. 8A.



Fig. 8* BCE2030 & BCE2636 MODELS



- 9. Repeat on opposite end.
- **10.** If equally sized compartments are desired or end panels are being used, count down fourteen grooves from the top of each post and place sleeves on each of these grooves. Without end panels, middle shelf can be varied to suit your application.
- **11.** Take a flat shelf and seat on sleeves as per step #6 (Fig. 9).

12. If end panels are being used, install in the same manner as step #8 (Fig. 10).



13. For a 3-shelf unit 3 sided enclosure, take one single sided extrusion and one double sided extrusion and install to one end of unit. Repeat for opposite end. Insert end panels as per step #8 (Fig. 7 and Fig. 8). Insert the long back panel in the same manner as the end panels (Fig. 11).



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14. Install split sleeves and shelf as step #10.

15. Repeat step #12 for the remaining enclosure parts (Fig. 12).

16. Place the last 4 pair of sleeves on the top groove of each post. Lower the handle shelf onto sleeves and seat as per step #6 (Figs. 13, 14, 15 and 16).



17. Check all shelves to insure corners are locked onto the sleeves. Re-seat if separation occurs.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

The cart shelves are constructed of a polyethylene polymer. The following are recommended cleaning methods:

LIGHT SOIL

If routine (daily) cleaning is practiced, a mild soap and warm water should be sufficient to keep the unit clean.

HEAVIER SOIL

If cleaning has been postponed, solvent or emulsion type cleaners that can be applied with bare hands and a soft brush will give excellent results. Such cleaners are available under various brand names and detergent suppliers can recommend materials appropriate for use on plastics.

EXTREME SOIL

Abrasive type cleaners should only be used when absolutely necessary, and the manufacturer's instructions must be carefully followed. Every effort should be made not to allow the unit to reach the condition where this type cleaning is required.

AFTER EACH CLEANING, THE UNIT SHOULD BE WIPED DRY WITH A CLEAN SOFT CLOTH.

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
